

Dear Parents and Carers,

As the national response to Covid-19 develops and changes, we have received some updated guidance from Staffordshire County Council that we have been asked to share with you. This is new guidance around accessing a test for Covid-19.

**Message from Staffordshire County Council**

***It is important to remember that anyone who has one of the main Covid-19 symptoms of a persistent cough, a high temperature, a new cough or the loss of taste or smell must self-isolate immediately and book a test.***

***However, with many people displaying other symptoms, the local authority are asking residents in Staffordshire to consider getting tested as a precaution if they have other symptoms such as:***

- ***Headaches***
- ***Aches and pains***
- ***Feeling very tired for no good reason***
- ***Sore throat***
- ***Runny nose***
- ***Sneezing***
- ***Sometimes 'tummy ache' in children***

***People with any of these symptoms can carry on going to school or work if they are well enough to do so and only need to self-isolate if the test comes back positive.***

***The national testing centres across the county have good availability, and can be booked through the NHS website. People booking a test through this website need to check the 'My council has asked me to get a test' option.***

***There are community testing sites that change on a weekly basis. People can view if there are any sites set up near them by visiting <https://staffordshire.zipporah.co.uk/TrackAndTrace>***
