GCSE Geographical Skills and Fieldwork.

As part of the government's specification at GCSE all students are required to undertake fieldwork in relation to processes in both physical and human geography. This is an integral part of the new specification and gives student the opportunity to see the classroom teaching in a real life setting. As you will be aware, back in September, we visited Cannock Chase to investigate River Landscapes. In order to fulfil the urban fieldwork requirement, the Geography department will be taking year 11 students into Lichfield to investigate Urban Environments. This has been planned for the afternoon of Thursday 23rd March 2023 during period 4 and period 5.

Please can you return this reply slip with permission to attend, any medical conditions and emergency contact details **no later than Friday 17th March**. As the trip will finish at the end of the day students may be dismissed from Lichfield City Centre. If this is acceptable, please indicate below. If not, students will be escorted back to school by staff. If this is the case, we will be back at school by 3.10pm. There will be points where your child is unsupervised by a member of staff. Students will be required to wear their Nether Stowe uniform, however they may wish to bring a coat/waterproof jacket as they will be outside for the afternoon.

Behaviour

Students participating in this visit will need to have a record of good behaviour and demonstrate that they can obey safety and other rules. Anyone whose behaviour becomes unacceptable after the trip has been booked may be excluded or required to return home early and any expenses incurred will be the responsibility of their parents/carers.
