Autumn 2	<u>Free time</u> This topic demonstrates how to describe your free time and more advanced grammar skills required for the GCSE.	<u>Milestone 2</u> 45 minute exam, skills based with some short answer responses to demonstrate understanding. Extended responses will draw on the knowledge from Autumn Term 1. 50 mark paper.	<u>10/12/18</u>
Spring 1	<u>Routine and festivals</u> This topic will enable pupils to describe daily routine, festivals and celebrations at GCSE level.	<u>Progress Check 2</u> 45 minute exam, multiple choice, short answers and extended responses make up the 50 mark paper.	<u>11/02/19</u>
Spring 2	<u>Where you live</u> This topic demonstrates how to describe where you live and your region.	<u>Milestone 3</u> 45 minute exam, short answer responses to demonstrate understanding. Extended responses will draw on the knowledge from Spring term. French grammar and/or translation skills will also be tested.	<u>25/03/19</u>
Summer 1	<u>Holidays and travel</u> This topic links to GCSE as it looks at holiday vocabulary and the grammar required to sentence build.	<u>Progress Check 3</u> 45 minute exam, multiple choice, short answers and extended responses make up the 50 mark paper.	<u>20/05./19</u>
Summer 2	<u>Exams and mocks</u> Students will develop and consolidate skills required directly for the mock GCSE exams.	<u>Milestone 4 - End of Year Exam</u> 45 minute exam, multiple choice, short answer and extended writing responding to questions based on the whole years' work.	<u>24/06/19</u>
