Year 11 and Year 13 Assessments

Subjects and qualifications will use all available standardised and moderated assessment information from the start of the course to inform and identify the standard the student is currently working at.

We will also provide students in Year 11 and Year 13 with an overview of the standard they are currently working at - in each subject - week beginning 19th April.

Year 11 and Year 13 'leaving' Date

I can confirm that the last day of compulsory attendance for Year 11 and Year 13 pupils will be **Friday 28th May**.

For our many Year 11 pupils who will be joining our Sixth Form, we will be providing further information regarding a timetable of bridging and transitions lessons in all Sixth Form subjects, which will start after May half-term.

Insight

In school we have moved to a new information management system: Bromcom. Insight, our current system for notifying and informing parents, therefore, will cease to operate from **Wednesday 31st March**.
