History enrichment trip: Liverpool and Black Country Museum

As part of the enrichment programme in school the History department are offering a 2-day enrichment trip on Tuesday 19th July and Wednesday 20th July. This trip has a maximum of 45 spaces available and is suitable for students in any year group within school. Trip places will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. The 2-days out will be spent in Liverpool and the Black Country Museum respectively. The full cost of the trip is £28 per student for entry to all museums visited and the transport to and from them. The trip will be on parent pay on the 4th May 2022 at 9am. This will secure your child's place on the trip once paid.

Plans for each day

Day 1: Trip to Liverpool students will leave school at 9am and head to the Liverpool Maritime Museum, where students will have chance to visit the International Slavery Museum and Titanic Museums within this. As a group we will then head to the Museum of Liverpool walking along the docks, where we will have lunch. Then students will have time to go round the Museum of Liverpool which has 3 floors and various exhibitions. We will then return to school to arrive back at 3pm.

Day 2: Trip to Black Country Museum where students will have the chance to visit the various buildings around the site which are set from the Victorian era up to WW2. They will also be able to free-roam the site and visit the fish and chip shop, sweet shop or bakery if they wish to. Students will then check in with staff at lunchtime. Before leaving the site students will have chance to visit the gift shop before returning to school to arrive back at 3pm.

What should students wear?

Students will be allowed to wear appropriate non-uniform – no crop tops, shorts, inappropriate imagery or slogans. The museums in Liverpool are both indoor, but students will have to walk between the sites. The Black Country Museum is an outdoor site, which will require suitable attire for the weather and comfortable shoes as the site is fairly large.

What do students need to bring?

Students will need to bring a packed lunch with them on both days. At the Museum of Liverpool there is a small café where student can purchase some food – however a packed lunch is recommended. The Black Country Museum does have some historical shops which sell food such a fish and chip shop and bakery. If students wish to purchase food, they will need to bring additional money for this – it will be the students' responsibility to look after this. Both museums have gift shops as well if students wish to purchase any small items.

By making the payment on Parentpay, you are consenting for your child to take part in the visit and confirming that you have read and understood the details contained in this letter. We will also require you to complete an emergency contact form a week before the date of the visit. Pupils will not be able to take part without a fully completed form.

Behaviour

Students participating in this visit will need to have a record of good behaviour and demonstrate that they can obey safety and other rules. Anyone whose behaviour becomes unacceptable after the trip has been booked may be excluded or required to return home early and any expenses incurred will be the responsibility of their parents/carers.
