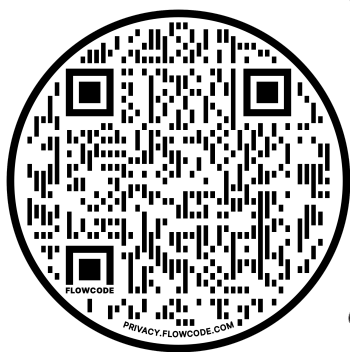
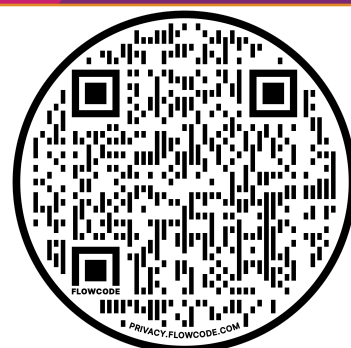

Scan the QR code for more information on some of the different types of owl you could draw.



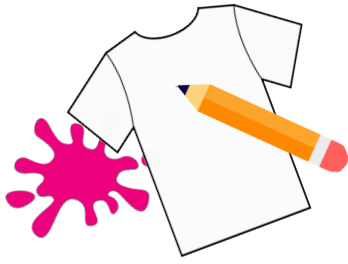

- 4) Include a photo or video of yourself taking part in a 'green' activity, or create some artwork inspired by the environment, conservation or nature.





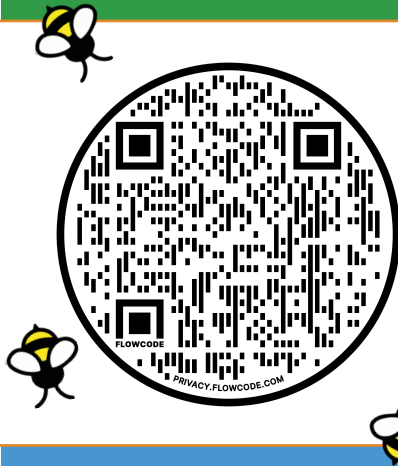
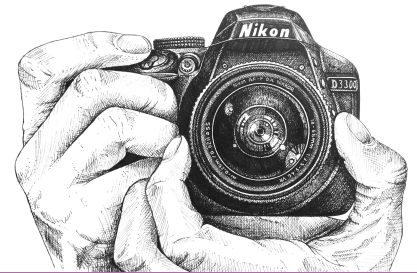
DESIGN A T-SHIRT
