#### Year 7 Team Building Residential - PGL Boreatton Park (Shrewsbury)

Our year 7 cohort will be attending PGL during March this year, the dates are being finalised as we have final numbers for the year group. As soon as we have final dates confirmed, I will be back in touch ASAP. Below is the remaining details of the trip. The trip has moved to facilitate with supporting parental costs due to an increasing number of our feeder primary schools attending a residential in Y6. Once we have our final numbers, costing will also be confirmed.

The initial itinerary is as follows:

#### **Monday –** Arrival at school for normal time (8:30am)

Students are required to enter as normal through the student entrance where they will be directed to drop off their belongings in the sports hall. Staff will be on hand to support with this process. Students are also required to bring a packed lunch for lunch time for this day only. Students can attend in non-school uniform suitable for activities in the afternoon. Those not attending the residential must remain in normal school uniform for the full week.

Students will be leaving at 10:30am to depart to centre via coach. The address is as follows:
