

Assemblies

The purpose of assemblies at Nether Stowe School is:

1. To promote the vision and ethos of the school.
2. To promote wider British values.
3. To tackle social disadvantage and enrich students' cultural capital by developing their understanding of the world around them.
4. To tackle emerging whole school safeguarding trends.
5. To celebrate and share success of Nether Stowe Students.

Types of assemblies at the Nether Stowe School:

Assemblies are planned using one of the categories below:

Vision and Ethos Assembly	An assembly delivered by a senior leader. In the assembly they will explore and share the school's ethos. These could be based on an aspect of A PROUDER way or a particular British Value.
Celebration Assembly	An assembly to celebrate success of students. The assembly can include: praise and rewards, sporting success for the teams at NSS, recognition for students who perform in sports etc outside of school as well as advertising all the enrichment opportunities that exist in the school.
Single Issue Assembly	Assemblies which raise awareness of an issue or cause. This could link to the PSHE curriculum or a wider societal event such as remembrance. Assemblies could also be used to address emerging safeguarding issues. Assemblies could be led by staff or student leaders.
