Children's University

The Nether Stowe School is proud to be part of the Children's University™ Scheme which aims to raise aspirations, celebrate and boost achievement, in addition to fostering a love of learning outside of the classroom, so that children can make the most of their abilities and interests.

All students across Key Stage 3, 4 and 5 will have the opportunity to take part in Children's University at Nether Stowe. Students can collect stamps online via their online passports to demonstrate the number of hours of Children's University validated enrichment activities they have participated in.

With lots of these activities on offer in school, every student should be able to complete 30 hours as a minimum. Yet students can gain hours outside of school with registered 'learning destinations' across the UK. When students complete their 30 hours of 'study' this will allow them to receive a Bronze award. Some students may go even further and achieve a Silver (60 hours) or even Gold Award (100 hours). Students completing over a 100 hours of learning activities will be invited to a very special graduation ceremony to be held at the University of Birmingham in June 2024 with invitations extended to parents/carers to watch.
